ADOPTER'S AGREEMENT

1. I agree that the pet is being adopted for myself and he/she will not be sold, adopted, or given to any other persons, including an animal shelter.

2. I agree that the cat will live with me and my family inside my home/apartment. If the cat is not spayed/neutered prior to adoption, proof of surgery must be mailed to the rescue within 30 days of the procedure. I agree to care for the animal in a loving and humane manner; this includes supplying adequate food, water, love, attention, and medical care if/when necessary.

3. I agree that if at any point I cannot keep the pet, I will return the cat to the Wildlife Freedom Foundation, Inc. (aka WFF) and without requesting a fee. I agree that I will give an advance notice to the WFF and assist, if necessary, with all the necessary steps for a safe return of the cat to the WFF.

4. I understand and agree that the WFF makes no guarantees about the animal's temperament and is and will not be responsible for future damages or injuries caused by the pet.

5. I give the WFF permission to call or visit my home at any reasonable times to assure that the cat is being properly treated and cared for. (Your initials here)

ADOPTION FEE:

We will review your application and then get back in touch. If you do decide to adopt a cat from us, we suggest a fee of \$ 175 (per adult cat) or \$ 250 (per kitten) Senior Cat (10 years and older): \$100 adoption fee. The adoption fee for each cat is dependent on many factors including age, behavior, medical needs, and demand.

All of our cats have already been:

- Spayed or neutered
- Vaccinated
- Dewormed
- Tested for FeLV (Feline Leukemia) and FIV
- Microchipped

** If unforeseen circumstances arise and you are unable to keep your adopted pet, we ask that the pet be returned to the Wildlife Freedom Foundation so that we will be able to find a new loving home for him/her. NO questions asked.
